20 Minutes late over an academic year equates to 13 days of learning lost.

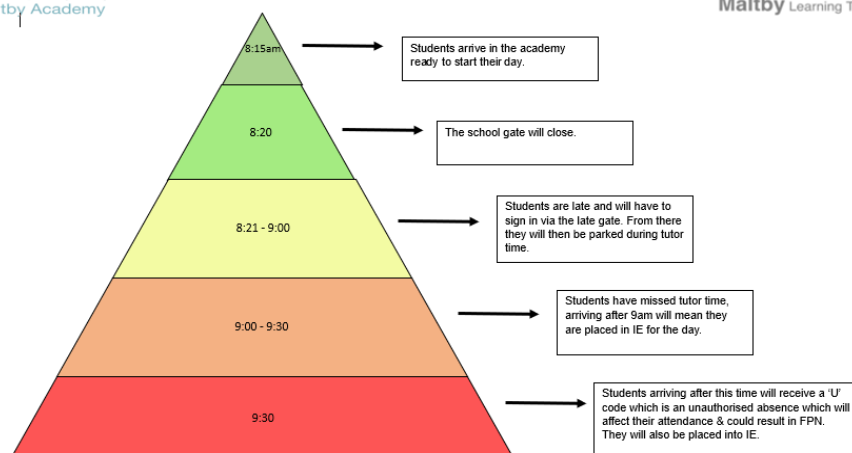
30 Minutes late over an academic year equates to 19 days of learning lost.

LATE TO SCHOOL PROCEDURE

To minimise the amount of students arriving late to the Academy we have implemented a new procedure.

Students need to aim to be in the Academy by 8.15am as the gates will be closing at 8.20am.

Below you will find information regarding our new late to school procedure. In addition to this we will be monitoring lateness very closely, students who are late twice in a week will also be placed in Internal Exclusion. Letters will be sent home to parents/carers at the end of each term if students have been late multiple times.



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Class Charts

As you will know, student registers and behaviour management is taken via Class Charts. Many of our parents/carers still don't access their accounts for a number of reasons. However, from September all communication from MyEd will be replaced by Class Charts.

To access Class Charts you will need an activation code to link you to your child, please contact the Attendance Office to obtain this.

Once activated you can use your App to monitor students registers, behaviours and detentions, report illness and so much more.

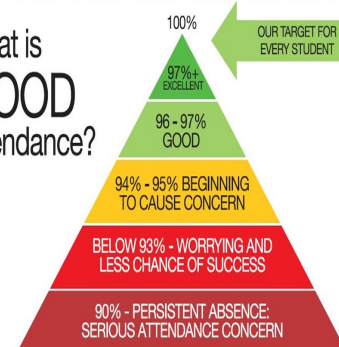


Half Term Attendance
