National Holocaust Centre; Nottingham; Tuesday 25th June 2024

I am writing to inform you that your child has been invited to visit The National Holocaust Centre and Museum on Tuesday 25th June 2024. The purpose of the visit gives students the chance to learn about the Holocaust and why it happened through objects and survivor testimony. This visit is a fantastic opportunity to consolidate the work that your child has already studied this year within the RS and History curriculums. The visit will include activities such as opportunities to listen to live and recorded survivor testimony as well as learn about museum artefacts.

Although the trip is being subsidised by the Academy, the cost per student will be £20.00. This will cover the cost of the coach and entry to the Holocaust Centre.

There are a limited number of spaces available for this exclusive opportunity so we ask that if your child would like to take part in this visit, please complete the attached interest form by Wednesday 1st May 2024. Link to the form below.

We will meet in the Atrium at 9.00am and the coach will depart at 9.30am prompt to travel to The National Holocaust Centre in Nottingham and we will return at approx. 2.45pm. Lunch is not provided at the event so students will need a packed lunch. If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals, please indicate this on the parental consent form and a packed lunch will be provided. All students attending are expected to uphold the values of Maltby Academy at all times on the trip.
