There has been a continuous trend of improvement in classroom behaviour in recent years at Maltby Academy evidenced by a significant increase in the numbers of students being able to access rewards and a significant reduction in lessons being impacted by poor behaviour.

We continue to strive to foster an environment where all students can learn free of disruption in order to maximise their learning and progress and so that they can be equipped with the best possible life chances when leaving school.

From September, we will be making minor changes to sanctions for disruptive classroom behaviour.
