

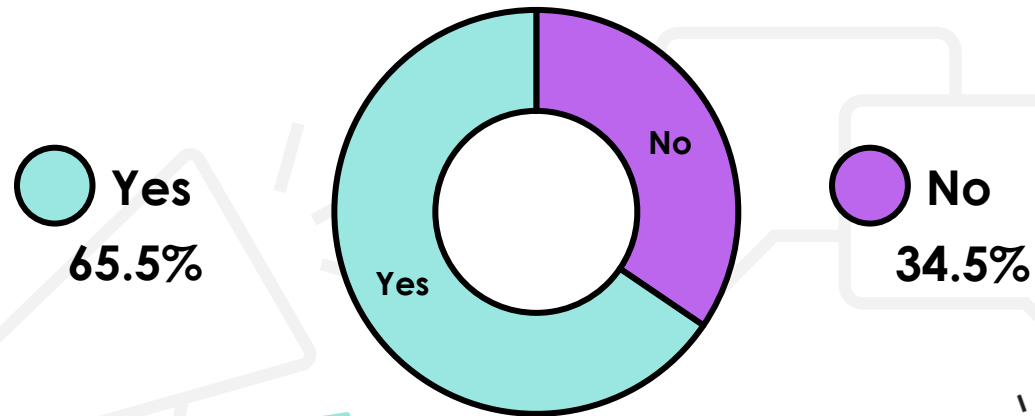


Vote Results:

Student research points:

- Explore the concerns musicians have about streaming.
- Investigate how Spotify and other music streaming apps use data to recommend playlists and new music.
- Find out what musicians have been doing to keep afloat in lockdown beyond streaming and internet shows.
