

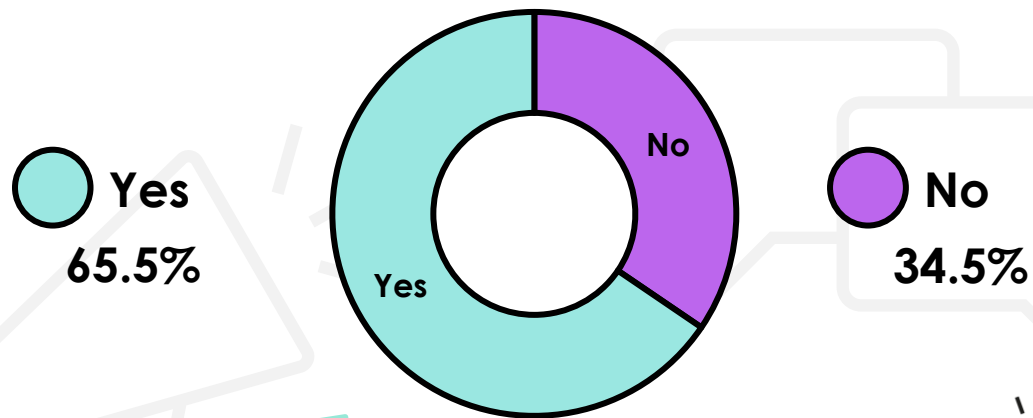


Vote Results:

- Find out about how much of the foreign aid budget goes towards supporting refugees.
