

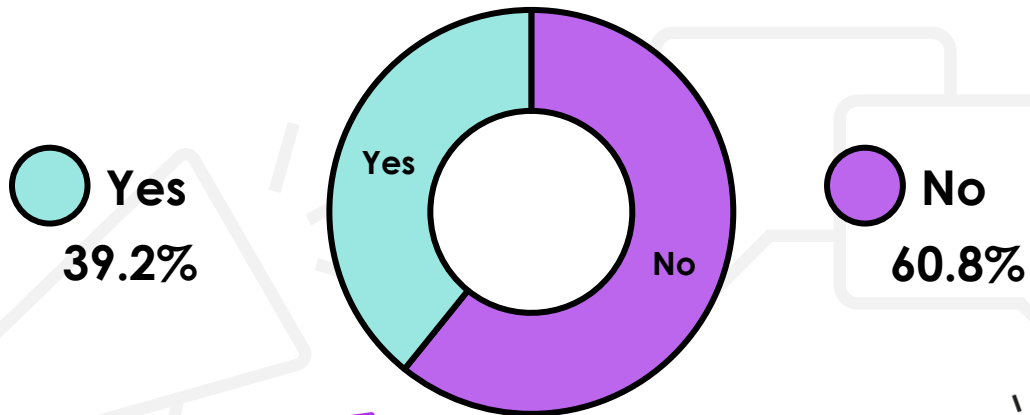


# Vote Results:
